

These requirements are for USDA programs, requirements may differ for non-USDA partners

What type of IDs are acceptable?

- IDs do not need to show a picture. Acceptable IDs include (but are not limited to): A Driver's license, CSFP Yellow Card, Photo ID containing the participant's date of birth, Birth Certificate, Social Security Administration record, Passport or passport card (regardless of expiration date), Census documents, including Tribal census records, Baptismal certificate, Military discharge documents or any reasonable, non-questionable document establishing the participant's age. Please see DES website.

What if a client forgets or does not have their ID?

- Clients without ID may receive donated product, but not USDA commodities (TEFAP or CSFP Product)

What if a client is not comfortable sharing required information?

- Clients who are not comfortable showing an ID or providing required information may receive donated product, but not USDA commodities

What if a client does not have a permanent address?

- If the client is transient, click "no fixed address/undisclosed" under county in client's profile in L2F

Can our agency ask clients for other information when receiving product?

- Agencies may ask for additional information from clients with permission from your St. Mary's Representative, but this information, or other documents, cannot be required for clients to receive product. Agencies may not use information from Link2Feed or sign in sheets for purposes other than food distribution.
