This food distribution center operates a federally funded program that helps supplement the diets of those in need by providing them with emergency food and nutrition assistance at no cost. To receive government product (TEFAP or CSFP), you must show proof of address and identification.

- We can run reports to look for trends and and learn more about the community, but the reports will not identify any specific, individually identifiable information.

Frequently Asked Questions

What personal information do I have to share?

In order to receive USDA foods, we will require your first and last name, date of birth, proof of address, and the number of people in your household.

Will I have to show my ID every time I receive food?

Yes, please bring your ID with you each time you visit our food pantry if you would like to receive government product. Even if the volunteer or staff recognize you, they are required to ask for identification from every neighbor on each visit.

What if I don't want to provide my identification?

If you do not want to provide your information or if you feel uncomfortable answering any questions, we respect that choice and will do our best to provide provide non-government services to you no matter what.
