

2025 PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES

CSFP (130% FPL)

The Commodity Senior Food Program (CSFP) also known as the “Commodity Supplemental Food Program” and “Food Plus” works to improve the health of low-income persons who are at least 60 years of age by supplementing their diets with a monthly package of nutritious food at no cost.

To be eligible for CSFP, a person must reside in Arizona, be at least 60 years old, and have a total household income that does not exceed 130% of the federal poverty level. (See following table)

TEFAP (185% FPL)

The Emergency Food Assistance Program (TEFAP) is a federally funded program that helps supplement the diets of low-income Americans, including elderly people, by providing them with emergency food and nutrition assistance at no cost.

A household is eligible to receive a TEFAP package if the total gross income for the household does not exceed 185% of the Federal Poverty level. (See following table) Persons receiving SNAP (food stamp) benefits are automatically eligible to receive TEFAP.
